
Happy Birthday To A Classic



Measurements:

- Basic White Thick cardstock (4-1/4" x 11", scored at 5-1/2" to form the card base)
- Soft Succulent cardstock (4-1/4" x 5-1/2", 1-5/8" x 4-3/4", 2-1/2" x 3-1/2", larger than 2" square)
- He's The Man designer series paper (Early Espresso pattern: 4" x 5-1/4", Cajun Craze pattern: 1-1/2" x 4-5/8", Sahara Sand pattern: 2-3/8" x 3-3/8")

Stamps, Dies and More:

He's All That bundle (He's All That stamp set + All That dies)

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere the Early Espresso designer series paper to Soft Succulent cardstock. Add to the card base.
- 2. Adhere the Sahara Sand pattern to Soft Succulent cardstock and add to the card base, 1/2" from the right side and the top.
- 3. Make a banner from the Cajun Craze designer series paper, by cutting a snip in the end. Mat onto Soft Succulent cardstock, and cut a matching snip in the end. Add to the card base, 3/8" from the left side.

- 4. Ink the sentiment in Early Espresso ink. Stamp onto Soft Succulent cardstock. Die cut out with the scalloped All That die. Use dimensionals to add to the card base in the position shown.
- 5. Accent with three He's The Man die cut stars. Accent the centers of the stars with rustic metallic dots.
